Guide for Discussion, Reflection and Listening (cont.)

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Which characters or scenes stood out to you the most? Which were the most interesting?
- 2. How do you think Jesus' parents struggles in raising him?
- 3. Nicodemus sat down and talked with John. When is the last time you sat down with someone you might not disagree with and simply said, "Tell me more."
- 4. Nicodemus cam e to John the Baptist asking many questions, wanting to "know his name." John's response was "All your life you have been asleep?" What did John the Baptist mean? John referred to the Bible verse in Luke 3:3-6.
- 5. What did you think of Eden's response to Peter's calling by Jesus?
- 6. Just as the servants had to draw the water before they saw the miracle, what are ways you can step out in faith because of God's promises?
- 7. Jesus asked Thomas to Follow Him. This is the same person as "Doubting Thomas" from after Jesus died. What did you think of his character?
- 8. What did you think of this interpretation of Jesus' interaction with his mother over the wine? Does it seem like the normal way we see this portrayed?
