#### Personal Reflection Question:

- What is your one Big Question from this episode? (What captured your imagination and what would you ask God about the events portrayed?)
- What quote/ moment from this episode was most impactful to you?

*"No amount of learning can bring you closer to God or make you more or less precious to Him. He is always right here, right now, with you, for you." (Philip)*

# Guide for Discussion, Reflection and Listening (cont.)

## Discussion Questions:

1. Which moment stood out to you the most? Which did you find hit you the most or was most relatable? Why?
2. What did you learn about the disciples, and what do you think the producers were trying to communicate?
3. How does Jesus disrupt cultural dynamics? Personal dynamics?
4. What did you think about the opening conversation between Philip and Matthew about the Psalms, the passage, and what Philip said about God? Do you feel God with you right here, right now?
5. Is this picture of daily life as a disciple of Jesus as they is depicted in this episode what you would have expected?
6. In what ways could you relate to these conversations and their concerns about Jesus?
7. How do you feel about Simon's treatment of Matthew? How powerful is it that Simon says he can't forgive him for what he's done, when you know Simon will need great forgiveness from Jesus for a later betrayal?
8. Jesus returned to camp exhausted from ministry. His condition stunned the disciples into silence. Why?
9. Mother Mary rushed to Jesus when he was a mess at the end of the day. How did that make you feel? What did that say about Mother Mary's relationship with Jesus, considering her concerns from earlier in the episode?
