Guide for Discussion, Reflection and Listening (cont.)

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Which moments stood out to you the most? Which were the most moved by? Why?
- 2. Why can't the disciples agree on how to help prepare for the sermon event?
- 3. Which of the Beatitudes feels closest to you? What about the hardest or farthest from you?
- 4. Think about each of the beatitudes. Can you think of one person for each of the traits— as they portray Jesus thinking of each of the disciples as he puts together the beatitudes.
- 5. Why do you think Jesus chose Matthew to help him write the Sermon on the Mount?
- 6. What role did each off the disciples play in the creation of the Sermon? What role would you have played?
- 7. What is another translation of the word, "Blessed"? How does changing the translation of that word, change the meaning of the Beatitudes?
- 8. In this episode, we see a lot of returning characters from Season 1. It shows not just how far Jesus' ministry has come, but also how is a good reminder to remember where we started. Where did your faith start? Who were the first people to support you in your journey?
